**SINGULAR** 

NOMINATIVE: puella portam videt. The girl sees the gate. subject

GENITIVE: porta est puellae. The gate is the girl's possession (It is the gate of the girl).

**DATIVE**: rēgīna portam **puellae** dat. The queen gives the gate **to the girl**. (The queen gives **the girl** the gate.)

ACCUSATIVE: rēgīna puellam videt. The queen sees the girl. direct object
