SINGULAR

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| NOMINATIVE: subject | puella portam videt. | The girl sees the gate. |
| GENITIVE: possession | porta est puellae . | The gate is the girl's (It is the gate of the girl). |
| DATIVE: indirect object | rēgīna portam puellae dat. | The queen gives the gate to the girl . (The queen gives the girl the gate.) |
| ACCUSATIVE: direct object | rēgīna puellam videt. | The queen sees the girl . |
| ABLATIVE: object of preposition | porta est in puellā . | The gate is in the girl . (Or: The gate is on the girl .) |

PLURAL

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| NOMINATIVE: subject | puellae portam vident. | The girls see the gate. |
| GENITIVE: possession | porta est puellārum . | The gate is the girls' (It is the gate of the girls). |
