


FIRST DECLENSION porta, —ae (f) "gate"

SINGULAR

Nominative: subject	porta bestiās videt.	The gate sees the beasts.
GENITIVE: possession	bestiae rēgīnam portae monent.	The beasts warn the gate's queen. (The beasts warn the queen of the gate .)
DATIVE: indirect object	rēgīna bestiās portae dat.	The queen gives the beasts to the gate . (The queen gives the gate beasts.)
ACCUSATIVE: direct object	bestiae portam vident.	The beasts see the gate .
ABLATIVE: obj. of prep., etc.	bestiae in portā ambulant.	The beasts walk in the gate . (Or: The beasts walk on the gate .)

Nominative: subject	portae bestiam vident.	The gates see the beast.
GENITIVE: possession	bestia rēgīnās portārum monent.	The beast warns the gates' queens. (The beast warns the queens of the gates .)
DATIVE: indirect object	rēgīnae bestiam portīs dant.	The queens give the beasts to the gate . (The queen give the gates the beast.)
ACCUSATIVE: direct object	bestia portās videt.	The beast sees the gates .
ABLATIVE: obj. of prep., etc.	bestia in portīs ambulant.	The beast walks in the gates . (Or: The beast walks on the gates .)
