

THIRD DECLENSION ADJECTIVES

They come in 3 flavors:

- a.) adjectives of 3 endings (that is: there are different endings in the singular nominative for all three genders),
- b.) adjectives of 2 endings (masculine and feminine endings are identical; neuters are different in the nominative and *āccusative*)
- c.) adjectives of 1 ending (only one form for nominative sg. in all genders).

a.) Adjective of 3 Endings:

ācer, ācris, ācre “sharp, harsh, keen”

ABLATIVE:	ācribus	ācribus	ācribus

b.) Adjective of 2 Endings:

omnis, omne “each, every (sg.); all (pl.)”

ABLATIVE:	omnī	omnī
VOCATIVE:	omnis	omne

GENITIVE:	omnium	omnium
DATIVE:	omnibus	omnibus
ACCUSATIVE:	omnēs (omnīs)	omnia
ABLATIVE:	omnibus	omnibus
VOCATIVE:	omnēs	omnia

c.) Adjective of 1 Endings:

pār, paris “equal”

GENITIVE:	paris	paris
DATIVE:	parī	parī
ACCUSATIVE:	parem	pār
ABLATIVE:	parī	parī
VOCATIVE:	pār	pār

PLURAL

NOMINATIVE:	parēs	paria
GENITIVE:	parium	parium
DATIVE:	paribus	paribus
ACCUSATIVE:	parēs (parīs)	paria
ABLATIVE:	paribus	paribus
VOCATIVE:	parēs	paria
